

Volunteer Requirement Ideas

PROPOSED: Starting in Fall 2016 - All BHFSC members (except coaches) will be required to contribute 20 hours per family per club membership year or a buy-out option of \$20 per hour.

Volunteer hours can be fulfilled in many ways, including:

Joint Winter Showcase with City

- Sell tickets at door
- Soliciting or selling cookies, coffee, hot chocolate
- Decorating
- Emcee
- Solicit and build silent auction baskets; man auction table
- Securing and selling Pizza at rehearsal
- Develop skating order; collect intros from skaters & payments for solos
- Collect/write bios for all Club skaters for program

Planning/executing special events like test sessions, clinics, public exhibitions or performances

Public relations for the club (developing/distributing marketing materials, contacting media, etc)

- Develop content for Club website
- Develop Club flyer for possible school distribution
- Reach out to area clubs to promote summer ice
- Managing Club Facebook page
- Updating Club Bulletin Board
- Coordinate Dasher board production
- Taking photos at shows; group & individual photos of Club skaters

Running consignment sale during competition & on first days for fall LTS sessions

Solicit/sells flowers during competition

Coordinate hair braiding fundraiser for competition

Coordinate concessions effort for hockey tournaments in June 2017; bake or solicit donations, man table

Ice monitoring/playing music for skaters

Coordinate shirt/jacket sales

Sell chuck a pucks; volunteer for Main Street Square or Civic Center events; Pizza Ranch, etc.

Taking votes for Zamboni Award

Help with public fall or winter carnivals or LTS exhibitions

Attending Board Meetings

Attending formal or informal meetings with City on behalf of Club (ie - ice users committee)

Do safety orientations for new Club members

Run contest to solicit cover art for Winter Showcase program
